

## TOURNAMENT RULES

1	The tournament consists of pool play divided into two Divisions, with a final for both Divisions. Divisions are composed of two pools, each pool having four teams. Every team is scheduled for three matches of pool play. The winners of the two pools in Division 1 will play a final match, as will the winners of the two pools in Division 2.
2	The team in each pool with the best match won-lost record will be the winner of that pool.
3	In the event of a tie, the team having the most games won will be the winner.
4	Matches are the best two out of three sets.
5	In the event of a 6-6 tie in either of the first two sets, a regular 7-point tie break will decide the winner of that set. The Coman method will be used for regular set tie breaks.
6	If a third set is necessary, a ten point tie break will be played <b>in lieu</b> of a full third set. These 10-point tie breaks are to be played using the Coman method.
7	Strictly limit warm ups to a <b>maximum</b> of 10 minutes.
8	The winning team is to provide the line score of the match in writing (fill out the match card) to the tournament supervisor immediately after play.
9	If the time limit for a match is exceeded (90 min), the match will be completed using "no ad" scoring.
10	You may reschedule a match subject to the following strict parameters: 1) your opponents must agree to any change, if they don't, then you forfeit the match, 2) the rescheduled match must take place by 4pm on Friday February 6th, and 3) rescheduled matches may be played at any venue at any time (subject to "1)" in this list of parameters).
