Old Business:

• September board minutes were approved as written.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer (Sandy Traylor)

- Reported that financials are up to date, balanced and in good order.
- Sandy discussed challenges with Bill Pay.
- Discussed getting a debit card for the account for the IONIS payment.
- Sandy to talk to Dick about transferring IONIS Drive, web hosting, and Mail Chimp to club.

Communications (Carole Rockland)

- Carole took new photo of sitting board for inclusion in Sun Lakes Splash.
- Carole reported that communications channels have been confusing. There has been a learning curve with the handoff from Dick to Carol Mellinger.

Facilities

- Tony Simonelli purchased and installed new court numbers. CJ informed Tony that the HOA will be responsible for this in the future.
- Judy recommended asking for a copy of the 2025 budget and reserve budget to see where expenses like the maintenance fee would fall. CJ to make a formal request with Jeff/Kwong in the next facilities meeting.
- The RBA approved replacement awnings, but no date has been fixed for the actual installation. Judy pointed out that the Ironwood court awnings also need replacing.

New Business
