Rules

Every team has 4 players comprised of 2 mixed doubles pairings: green and blue squads.
 Every team will play every other team twice during the six-week session, i.e. two rounds of competition.
 Teams remain fixed, but mixed double partners will swap/rotate their players after the first round of competition.
 Team players will choose a team captain who confirms weekly team readiness and signs off on match scores.
 Team captains will submit a team name chosen by team members (see below).
 Pre-match warm-up is 6:00 - 6:15 pm. Match play may start earlier, but no later than 6:15 pm.
 New tennis balls will be provided by the club for each tennis match.
 A play schedule and court assignment for each team will be forthcoming and posted to the club website.
Note: 4 courts are reserved for team players; 2 additional courts are reserved for drop-in sub players.

Scoring

Match play is one regular scoring 8-game pro-set.
 First to win 8 games, wins the match.
 If score is tied at 7-7, a 7-point **regular** tie break is played to determine the game 8 winner.
 Regular tie-breaks must be won by a two point margin; sides changed after every 6 points.
 Each team wins a point for every game won by their squads. Points are tallied and accumulated after each match.
 If any squad or team defaults due to a no-show or a late player, the default score is 0-8.
 Teams accumulate points, which are tallied weekly and determine the final winners.
Note: Winning games, not matches, is more important to winning the overall competition. It is possible for a team to lose every single match and win the overall competition, because every game won, counts!

Subs

If a regular team member cannot play, they will obtain a player from the "sub pool".
 There are two "priority" lady sub players, who need to be contacted first, before considering other subs.
 When utilizing a sub, a player must choose a sub of their same gender.
 If a player is injured during play, an appropriate sub can be drawn in from the drop-in court if available.
 New players may have their names added to the sub list with the Team Tennis Director's approval.

* For this first session, we are requesting team names that denote a specific **BIRD** species.
 Examples: "Bluejays, Sparrows, Hawks, Orioles, Cardinals, Eagles, Condors, Roadrunners", etc.
 Captains should submit two different name preferences to the Team Tennis Director in case of duplicate requests.
